

Cord of conduct for faculty:-

- ❖ Must comply with applicable policies, rules, regulations, norms and standards.
- ❖ There is a collective responsibility for upholding standards of conduct and compliance with all applicable rules and codes of conduct.
- ❖ Faculty members should follow the detailed instructions issued from time to time.
- ❖ Faculty members are encouraged to report suspected violations without jeopardizing their position or employment.
- ❖ Violations may result in disciplinary action, including termination.
- ❖ Teaching includes basic and optional courses, laboratory exercises, consultations and seminars.
- ❖ Proper management of student project work and relationship with industry/organizations is essential.
- ❖ Effective teaching methods, multimedia aids and learner-centered approaches are supported
- ❖ Faculty members are encouraged to be actively involved in research, scholarly activities and publications.
- ❖ They should contribute to the development of knowledge in their respective fields.
- ❖ Proper citation practices and adherence to ethical principles are essential.
- ❖ Faculty members must uphold the reputation of the teaching profession.
- ❖ Responsible for updating the teaching schedule.
- ❖ All correspondence should be conducted through the principal.
- ❖ Be polite to colleagues.
- ❖ Avoid open confrontation.
- ❖ Impartial decisions regarding students and staff.
- ❖ Regular attendance reflects academic commitment.
- ❖ Punctuality is essential.
- ❖ To observe ethical principles in research and scientific activity.
- ❖ Avoid humiliating, harassing or abusive behaviour.
- ❖ Adhere to the standards of the teaching profession.
