Cord of conduct for faculty:-

- Must comply with applicable policies, rules, regulations, norms and standards.
- There is a collective responsibility for upholding standards of conduct and compliance with all applicable rules and codes of conduct.
- * Faculty members should follow the detailed instructions issued from time to time.
- Faculty members are encouraged to report suspected violations without jeopardizing their position or employment.
- Violations may result in disciplinary action, including termination.
- Teaching includes basic and optional courses, laboratory exercises, consultations and seminars.
- Proper management of student project work and relationship with industry/organizations is essential.
- Effective teaching methods, multimedia aids and learner-centered approaches are supported
- Faculty members are encouraged to be actively involved in research, scholarly activities and publications.
- They should contribute to the development of knowledge in their respective fields.
- Proper citation practices and adherence to ethical principles are essential.
- Faculty members must uphold the reputation of the teaching profession.
- * Responsible for updating the teaching schedule.
- All correspondence should be conducted through the principal.
- Be polite to colleagues.
- Avoid open confrontation.
- Impartial decisions regarding students and staff.
- * Regular attendance reflects academic commitment.
- Punctuality is essential.
- To observe ethical principles in research and scientific activity.
- Avoid humiliating, harassing or abusive behaviour.
- Adhere to the standards of the teaching profession.
