

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding is executed on 4th October 2023 by and between **GOVT COLLEGE FOR WOMEN NARNAUL**, which expression shall include its successors and assigns, as represented by **PRINCIPAL GOVT COLLEGE FOR WOMEN NARNAUL** having its registered office at Shiksha Sadan, Ground floor Sector 2 herein referred to as "DHE-Haryana" or "First Party" hereafter through its authorized signatory.

AND

Viveka Nand Educational Society registered vide registration number **NNL/77 on 2006-07** registered with District Registrar/Registrar **Narnaul** has been allotted a new registration Number as under mentioned on this 30th april 2013 under the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 (Haryana Act No. 1 of 2012s

Section A

1. **WHEREAS** the First Party is primarily engaged in improving the learning environment and employment outcomes of the youth enrolled in non- technical Government Colleges of Haryana.
2. And **WHEREAS** the Second Party is a not-for-profit organization engaged in the facilitation of socio-emotional learning, 21st-century skills and career- oriented services to the youth through multiple state Govt. MOUs with technical education, higher education departments/ institutions, overseeing education/ skill development/ employment of youth around program design, curriculum development, monitoring & implementation & project management.
3. **WHEREAS** both the parties focus on betterment of youth and play a role in facilitating education and career development.
4. **WHEREAS** both the parties have mutually desired to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), which shall specify a detailed Scope of Work with roles and responsibilities of each party in this joint project to enrich the academic experience and better career preparation for students resulted in rewarding and career choices.
5. Unless terminated sooner in accordance with the scope of this document is valid for both the Parties for a period of three (03) years, which may be extended for one (1) more year based on mutual consent and agreement at that time.
6. • Promote outcome-based approach, culture of using empirical evidence through diagnostic & landscape studies and robust data- backed monitoring and evaluation framework and use of

Section B

To achieve the above-mentioned objectives, roles & responsibilities of each party are mentioned herewith:

GOVT COLLEGE FOR WOMEN NARNAUL or the first party will ensure the following:

1. A nodal officer at the college level, appointed by the Principal, will be responsible for the effective monitoring and implementation of the program.
2. PRINCIPAL GOVT COLLEGE FOR WOMEN NARNAUL will provide data, infrastructure, and administrative support, including venue for conducting workshops, meetings, seminars, etc., and access to age and gender wise relevant data of students and information related to the project for its smooth execution. The specific data requirement revolves around two key aspects: age and gender-wise the total number of students progressing to higher education and the count of students enters various employability avenues, encompassing placements, internships, entrepreneurship, and apprenticeships
3. Assist in the selection of a district-level champion to strengthen the programme at the district level.

Engage directly with faculties/students to ensure all the support & grievances are addressed

4. Enabling the central placement cell for consolidating all information related to industry linkage, Student placement, Training and Placements officers (TPO's) and committee members
5. Ensure that the current and previous documents/records of state higher education curriculum, assessment framework, placement records, training modules, format, data and tools are made available to **Viveka Nand Educational Society** for workshops, capacity-building initiatives and other project related activities

Viveka Nand Educational Society or the second party will ensure the following:

- 1) Conduct professional development programs for faculty members, alumni cell coordinator and the placement cell officer for delivering employability skills training and integrating activity-based learning for career preparation

- 2) Deliver Leadership Advancement Boot camps, training principals in academic and institutional leadership to enhance faculty development. industry partnerships, and placement outcomes in colleges
- 3) Addition of specific features in the MIS portal, which ensures better visualization, efficient management of placement data, virtual on boarding of employers and placement agencies, and developing an Alumni portal
- 4) Develop Digital Learning Resources (DLR) for faculties aligned with NEP recommendations, providing students access in quality learning Materials.
- 5) Build the capacity of Placement in charge's, strengthening student led placement cells, and collaborate with Industry expert partners to students for life after college.
- 6) Supporting each district, through the DHEDs/district level champion. in its efforts to implement the programme by including related programmatic activities in district plans and the wider state-level education strategy
- 7) Conduct a comprehensive study, mapping industries and anates in each district, identifying potential collaboration opportunities.
- 8) Facilitate formal partnerships between local colleges, promoting placement opportunities and support services by signing of relevant MOUs Support in Organizing regular industry and career talks in colleges across various domains.
- 9) Develop a pool of employability skills trainers from Industries and engage alumni as mentors to drive NEP goals related to employability outcomes
- 10) Drive PMU create a pool of Master Educators, and nd a a Professional Development Cell to strengthen project governmente, policy advisory, impact assessment, and alignment with NEP goals. Medha will assign 2 members to the Project Management Unit (PMU), constituting a total resource strength of 6 members.
- 11) Submit quarterly progress report to the steering committee, outlining the accomplished work and detailing the progress made.
- 12) Seek support from resource person of reputed institutions like IIMs. T Azim Premji University etc. for studies and capacity building processes.

C. Representations and Warranties

Each Party hereby represents and warrants that

- It has all requisite power and authority to execute this MoU and to perform its obligations hereunder.
- it will fulfill its obligations and responsibilities under this MoU in a manner that complies with all applicable laws.

D. Intellectual Property Rights & Marketing

- Each party acknowledges and agrees that each party owns all Intellectual Property Rights in the property belonging to each party. This MoU does not grant either party the rights to

C. Amendments

F. Amendments

- Either party may request changes to this MoU; any changes modifications, revisions, or amendments of this MoU which are mutually agreed upon and between the parties to this MoU shall be incorporated by the written instrument and effective when executed and signed by all the parties.

G. Entirety of MoU

- This MoU represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, and agreements in this regard, whether written or oral.

H. Severability

- If any portion of this MoU is Judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the Moll shall continue to be in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms effected by severance.

I. Relationship between Parties

The relationship of the parties of this Moll is that of independent entities, and nothing on this MoU nor the dealings of parties under this MoU shall be deemed to constitute or place them in the fiduciary relationship or any other relationship of trust or confidence, partnership, employer-employee, agency or Joint Venture relationship, and no party shall have the right to agree to obligations on behalf of any other party in any manner.

K. Risk Mitigation

- That in no event; either party shall be liable for any losses arising from or in connection with this MoU, pursuant to any claim by the other party against such party under any theory of liability (whether in contract, in tort or otherwise) if such losses could have been avoided and the other party had used reasonable efforts to avoid and mitigate them.


L. ARBITRATION

Both the parties shall use all reasonable endeavors to resolve or settle the disputes through mutual negotiation and discussions in connection with this MOU or the interpretation thereof. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts ('Disputes') arising out of this Agreement between the parties or arising out of or relating to or in connection with this Agreement or the performance or non-performance of the rights and obligations set forth herein or the breach, termination, invalidity or interpretation thereof which cannot be settled or resolved amicably shall be referred for arbitration to a suitable committee formed jointly by both the parties. The arbitral award shall be in writing and shall be final and binding on each party. None of the parties shall be entitled to commence or maintain any action in a court of law upon any Dispute arising out of or relating to or in connection with this MOU.

M. FORCE MAJEURE

If at any time during the course of the MoU it becomes impossible for either Party to perform any or all of their obligations for reasons of Force Majeure which shall be defined as "act of nature, invasion or acts of God or events beyond the reasonable control of either Party, i.e., any act of war, armed conflict, etc.", the parties shall contact for the appropriate action to be taken which may include suspension or cancellation of the Project or relief to the party from such obligations as long as Force Majeure persists.
