Alampur Navabrahma Temples




Alampur *Navabrahma* Temples include nine temples dedicated to Shiva. These temples date back to the 7th century A.D and were built by the Badami Chalukya rulers who were patrons of art and architecture. The sacredness of Alampur Temple is mentioned in the Skanda Purana. It is mentioned that Ardhanar performed a strict penance here for Lord Siva, Lord Siva appeared before him and blessed him with the powers of creation. Therefore, the name *Ardhanareshvara, Sargamashwara* is derived from the word Sargam meaning creation. Hence the temple is also known as Rudravelli Sargamashwara Temple. It is said that Sargamashwara Temple was constructed by Polakasa I c. 540 CE to 566 CE and is fine example of Chalukyan Architecture.

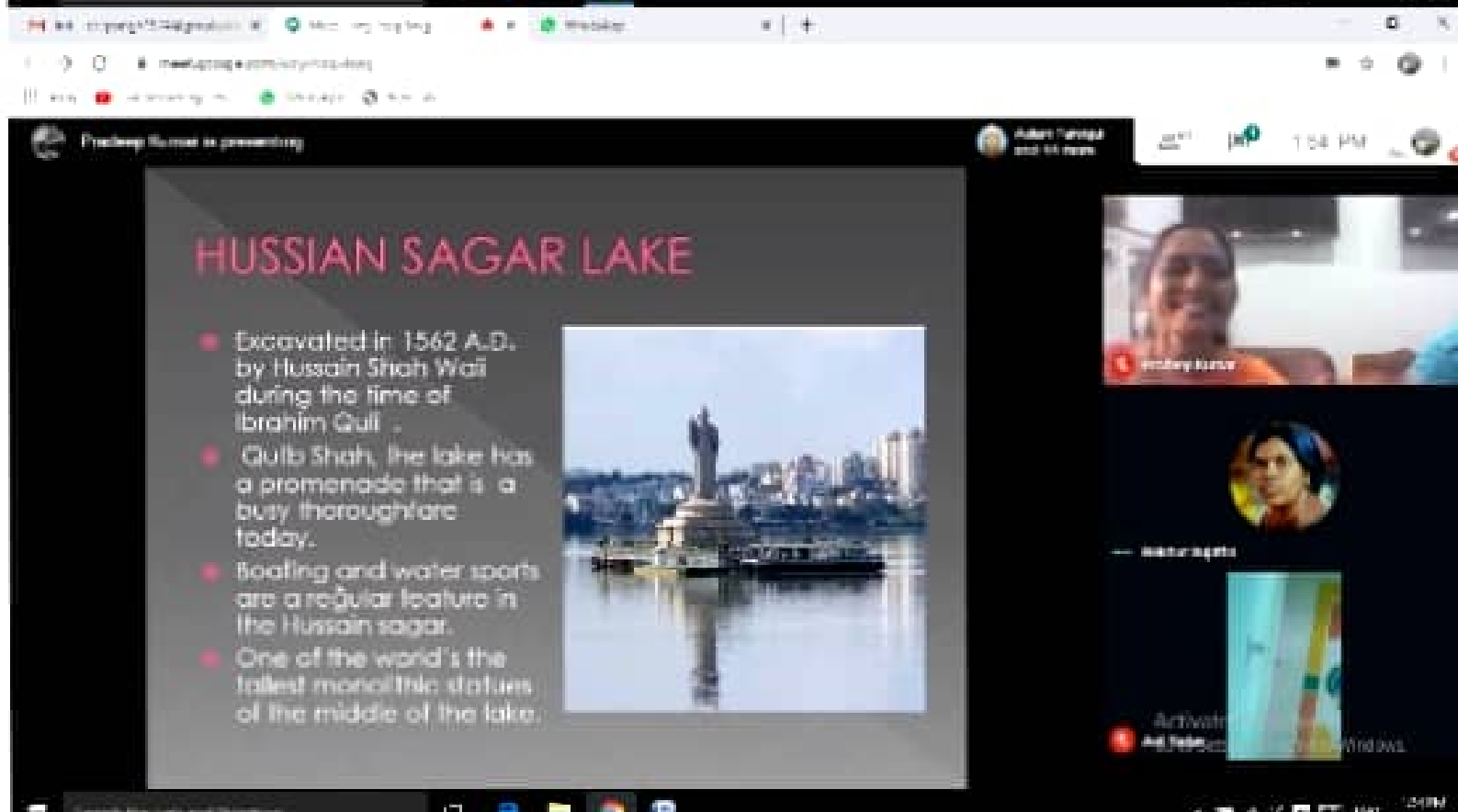
